

Studio Policy, Effective September 1, 2002

The Piano Studio year will consist of 36, one-half hour, weekly lessons.

Refer to Lesson Calendar attached to this Policy

Tuition is \$\$ per month each.

2 children in the same family is \$\$\$ per month

There will be a \$\$ discount for those who bring all 9 post dated cheques to the first lesson; \$\$ single and \$\$ family. (cheques will be returned for drop outs).

Payment is due before the first lesson of each month. Cheques received after the 2nd of the month will be surcharged.

There are no refunds once the month has begun. Lessons missed by the student will not be made up unless a full 24 HOURS NOTICE HAS BEEN GIVEN.

Attendance

In order to ensure success and continued progress for each student, it is essential to strive for consistent attendance at lessons.

Your lesson time is reserved for you each week whether or not you attend. Absences will be charged as a regularly attended lesson. If it is necessary for me to cancel lessons, I will credit your account.

Holidays

The studio will be closed October 13, December 19, 2003 until January 5, 2004, March 15, until March 19, 2003, May 24, 2004 and from June 12 until September 6, 2004.

Etiquette

Please do not bring friends to your piano lesson. No toys are to be brought to the studio. If you are to wait through your siblings lesson, then quiet activities and books are acceptable, however gameboys and other electronic games are to be left at home.
